

### **DEFEND AND EXTEND OUR NHS**

We would also create a healthy environment to live in, through a clean air act, through restrictions on adverts for unhealthy foods and alcohol and by promoting walking and cycling – funded by a carbon tax on windfall profits of oil and gas companies.

#### **FAIRER EDUCATION**

Greens believe schools should be inclusive, well funded, foster knowledge and self–expression.

We would abolish unnecessary stressful tests like SATs, encourage creativity and outdoor learning for all pupils and abolish tuition fees.

### **WARM AFFORDABLE HOMES**

Greens support retrofitting homes and building more new affordable homes on brownfield land – all funded by a wealth tax on the richest 1%.

Families want slower, calmer traffic to create safer streets for our children and grandparents/older people. Greens would prioritise this.

### **PROTECTING NATURE**

Greens are committed to not just protecting green spaces but enhancing them to help address the nature and climate emergencies. We would reverse the privatisation of public services like water. It is a scandal that rivers like the Mersey are used as a dumping ground for sewage while billions are paid in dividends and sky—high salaries to line private pockets.
