

BIRKENHEAD DESERVES A FLAGSHIP MARKET

Recently Green Councillors voted to keep exploring plans for a flagship market on the House of Fraser site — but Labour and Tory Councillors voted to scrap these plans.

Birkenhead Market Traders oppose being shoehorned into the former Argos store, underneath pollution from a multi-storey car park. Over 1,600 people have signed their petition, calling on Wirral Council to fulfil the promise and create a flagship market for Birkenhead.

Jo says, "Birkenhead deserves a better market at the heart of our town centre. There are government grants of £85 million to revitalise Birkenhead. Cleaning up and building on brownfield sites is essential to protect our precious green belt, parks and urban green spaces. Everything is connected."

JO CALLS FOR CEASEFIRE IN GAZA
